RULES of PLAY

TEAM REGISTRATION FEE: \$30.00 per team (including the Captain) due on or before February 1, 2010

RULES & FORMAT: All teams are allowed to register a designated alternate who is allowed to be included in the line up for a complete round. The Captain can change their line up for each round played. No substitutions during a round. Leagues with multiple teams in the same division can cross over alternates to make sure all teams have complete roster, once moved they must stay there. Each team **MUST** have a Non-Playing Captain (as passed at the September 1995 & October 98 Affiliate Meetings). The Captain will be the only person responsible for communicating with the Tournament Director at each venue. Each league is allowed to register a number of teams as per their membership numbers. Team players must play for the division they are registered in.

Multiple Teams - Same League:

Special rule: The draw will still be done Blind Draw filling each section as required. If a team is pulled and there is already a team from that league in the section then place the team just pulled into the next section. Continue to do this throughout the draw. If there are more teams than there are sections then you will start to duplicate teams in sections using the same format. If there are multiple teams from the same league in a section then the game against each other should be the first one played in the section.

DRESS CODE: It is the responsibility of each league to ensure that their players are wearing respectable playing attire.

FORMAT:

All events will be played Round Robin leading to Knockout.

If a section has only 3 teams then the first two will play. The team with the bye will play the loser of the first match then the winner of the first round will play the team that had the bye in the first round.

Darts Ontario Affiliate Director will have given options available to the Tournament Director for the number of sections and teams - these **MUST** be used. If draw has already been done by Darts Ontario Director – this **MUST** be used.

In the Round Robin & Knock-out all teams will play;

Doubles best 2 of 3 legs - 501

Singles best 2 of 3 legs **Super - First – Second – Ladies A** will play 501
Third & Ladies-B will play 401

NOTE: Super division depending on numbers can take vote of Captains to increase # of legs.

ORDER OF PLAY:

Winner of the toss will throw first in the first leg; loser of the toss will throw first in the second leg. If a deciding leg is required the winner of the original toss has choice of throwing for the bull first or second. When there is a tie when throwing for the bull both players darts will be removed and the players will throw again in reverse order.

Team Captains must do their complete line up for all their doubles and singles before any matches start - they will have 10 minutes to return completed sheet to the control table. Players on both teams are expected to share the chalking. Empty boards **MUST** be assigned to the next game. Do not wait for all games to finish before starting the next ones. All games will be played and the total matches won will decide a win or loss for that game on the Round Robin sheet. The total matches won will also be recorded on the Round Robin sheet. In the case of ties of total matches on the Round Robin the total games won will be used to break the tie.

Match - League "A" VS League "B"

Game -Individual Doubles / Singles game (Total 12)

If still tied then the Darts Ontario Tie-Breaker formula will be used to break ties, however the game will be:

Four (4) players to play a team game, one leg only of 1001 SIDO all teams in the tie will choose one player to throw for bull. The order of throwing for bull will be determined by the team number on the Round Robin sheet.

In the Knockout use the format supplied by Darts Ontario - the games for each team will be played until there is a definite winner - Darts Ontario rule for tiebreaker will be used if teams are tied at the end of regular game sheet.

Players will have only one 5 minute call from the control desk - if the player has not reported to their designated board by that time they will be eliminated from play. It is the responsibility of all to be ready to start play when their match is called.
